## CHAPTER 127.

AN ACT authorizing the commissioners of public lands to sell certain lands in Buffalo county belonging to the state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

**Description of lands to be conveyed.** SECTION 1. The commissioners of public lands are hereby authorized, instructed and directed, to sell and convey to Andrew Wilhelm, of Buffalo county, Wisconsin, at the price of one dollar and twenty-five cents per acre, the following described land, situate in Buffalo county, Wisconsin, to-wit: The south half of the northeast quarter of section number twenty-six, township twenty-three north, of range number fourteen west.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.

## **CHAPTER** 128.

AN ACT to provide fishways in dams, booms, piers and other obstructions on the Yellow river in the counties of Wood and Juncau in the state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Fishways to be maintained in all obstructions. SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of all and every person, persons or corporation owning, managing, occupying or having in charge any dam, boom, pier or other obstruction of any kind whatsoever.
