CHAPTER 189.

AN ACT authorizing the commissioners of fisheries to release a public easement in certain lands in Vernon county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in scnate and assembly do enact as follows:

Description of lands. Section 1. The commissioners of fisheries of the state of Wisconsin are hereby authorized to release the public easement to enter, for the purpose of fishing with hook and line, upon the north half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the northeast quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of section number twenty (20), and the north half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the northwest quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of section number twenty-one (21) of the town of Whitestown, Vernon county, Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 190.

AN ACT to amend section 1088 of chapter 49 of the statutes of 1898 relating to the collection of taxes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

All taxes levied a lien on land; when levied on timber, etc. Section 1. Section 1088 of chapter 49 of the statutes of 1898 is hereby amended by striking out the words "levy of such taxes" where the same appear in the ninth line of said section, and by inserting in lieu thereof the following: "first day of May in the year in which such taxes are levied," further amend
