taxes shall, in addition to the other aforesaid directions, therein require the city treasurer to pay out according to law, from the money so collected by him, to the person or persons lawfully entitled thereto the amount of the district school tax collected by him thereunder.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 197.\*

AN ACT to provide for binding the exchanges of the Wisconsin academy of sciences, arts and letters.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Binding of exchanges. Section 1. Section 341 of the revised statutes of 1898 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: "The secretary of state may authorize the state printer to bind in suitable binding all periodicals and other exchanges which the society shall hereafter receive, at a cost not exceeding one hundred and fifty dollars. The secretary of state shall audit the accounts for such binding."

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
