CHAPTER 252.

AN ACT to constitute the Platteville fair association a county agricultural society under the provisions of section 1460, of the statutes of 1898.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

When entitled to state aid. SECTION 1. The Platteville fair association, of Platteville, Grant county, Wisconsin, is hereby constituted and declared to be a county agricultural society under the provisions of section 1460 of the statutes of 1898, and entitled to state aid upon complying with the provisions of section 1463, statutes of 1898.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
