CHAPTER 254.

AN ACT authorizing the placing of the national flag over every voting place on general election and registration days.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Council, etc., may maintain flags over booths. Section 1. That the common councils of the cities, trustees of the villages, and the township boards of supervisors may place and display the national flag on suitable staff over every voting place on general election and registration days for township, village, city, county, state and national elections and maintain them during every hour of such days of voting and registration.

Expense of, part of general election expenses. Section 2. That such common councils, board of trustees, and township board of supervisors may provide the expense of such flags, and the erection, maintaining and care of the same, such expense to be included in and be a part of the general election expenses.

Section 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 255.

AN ACT to amend section 378 of the statutes of 1898, relating to the board of regents of the university of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Woman may be appointed on board. Section 1. Section 378 of the statutes of 1898 is hereby amended by inserting after "large" in line three of said section, "at least one of whom shall
