CHAPTER 289.

AN ACT to authorize the state board of control with the approval of the governor, to purchase lands at the Wisconsin reformatory.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Maximum price to be paid for land. Section 1. The state board of control, with the approval of the governor, is hereby authorized to purchase not to exceed one hundred and fifty (150) acres of land contiguous to the lands appurtenant to the Wisconsin state reformatory, and for the use thereof, at a price not to exceed one hundred and fifty (150) dollars per acre.

Appropriation. Section 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, a sum of money sufficient to paid for said land.

Section 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
