## CHAPTER 403.

AN ACT amending section 562a of the statutes of 1898 relating to investigations by the governor so as to extend its provisions to all state institutions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Power of governor; compensation of person appointed. Section 1. Section 562a of the statutes of 1898 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 562a. Whenever the governor shall deem it expedient to have an investigation made of any charitable, reformatory or penal institutions of the state or of any matter connected therewith, or of any other state institution, or employe in any of said institutions, he may appoint a suitable person, male or female, in his discretion to make such investigation and shall require a written report thereof. Such person shall receive a compensation of six dollars and fifty cents per day for each day actually and necessarily required in performing the duties imposed upon him and be reimbursed all actual expenses thereby incurred; such compensation and expenses being payable from the general fund.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
