CHAPTER 407.

AN ACT to repeal section 15 of chapter 311 of the laws of 1899, relating to the taking of fish by the commissioners of fisheries for the purpose of securing eggs for artificial propagation.

CHAPTER 408.

AN ACT to amend sections 1498, 1498a and 1498b of the statutes of 1898 as amended by chapter 312 laws of 1899, providing additional duties for the game wardens and deputy game wardens.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Duties and salary of fish and game warden; to perform duties of fire warden. Section 1. Section 1498 of the statutes of 1898 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "qualified" in line four of said section, "unless sooner removed" by inserting after the word "for" at the beginning of line nine in said section, he shall also perform the same duties as are in section 1636c as amended by chapter 353, laws of 1899, prescribed for fire wardens, and shall further report to the land commissioners any information relating to the state lands as shall from time to time be required and concerning any trespasses thereon which
