and game warden and shall at all times be held subject to his discretion and control in the performance of their duties. They shall also gather and transmit to the state fish and game warden any and all statistical information relative to fish and game as said fish and game warden shall from time to time call for. They shall also promptly make report concerning forest fires and any trespasses upon the public lands that may come to their knowledge.

Section 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 409.

AN ACT authorizing the appointment of an additional factory inspector and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Appointee to be a weman. Section 1. The commissioner of labor and industrial statistics shall have power to appoint one assistant factory inspector in addition to those now authorized by law who shall be a woman and who shall perform her duties under his direction and who may be removed by him for cause.

Salary of. Section 2. Said additional assistant factory inspector shall be paid a salary at the rate of one thousand dollars per annum, together with necessary traveling expenses to be paid out of money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated.

Section 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
