CHAPTER 414.

AN ACT to amend chapter 138 of the laws of Wisconsin for the year 1901 relating to salaries of justices and judges of supreme and circuit courts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

What judges to get increase. Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 138 of the laws of Wisconsin enacted in 1901 is hereby amended by striking out the words "hereafter to be chosen and" so that said section when amended shall read as follows: Section 2. The increase of salaries hereby provided for shall be paid only to justices and judges of said courts for terms of office hereafter to commence. Justices and judges now in office shall be paid during the remainder of their present terms, respectively, the same salaries and allowances for expenses, if any, that they now receive.

Conflicting laws repealed. Section 2. All acts and parts of acts which in any way conflict with the provisions of this act are bereby repealed.

Section 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
