CHAPTER 427.

AN ACT to appropriate to Lynn S. Pease and E. W. Chafin certain sums of money therein named for their services and expenses as special attorneys for the state of Wisconsin in the matter of the investigation of the industrial school for boys at Waukesha.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Appropriation clause. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to Lynn S. Pease the sum of two hundred and eighty-two dollars and to E. W. Chafin the sum of eighty dollars as compensation in full for their services as special attorneys for the state of Wisconsin in the matter of the investigation of the industrial school for boys, in full for all their expenses and disbursements in said matter.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
