CHAPTER 458.

AN ACT to amend chapter 365 of the laws of 1897 as amended by chapter 345 of the laws of 1899, relating to estimating, appraising and sale of state lands.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Withdrawing all lands from sale; appraisal of. Section 1. Section 6 of chapter 367 of the laws of 1897, as amended by chapter 345 of the laws of 1899, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 6. All other lands owned by the state shall be withdrawn from public sale; all such lands so withdrawn and all lands which may hereafter be selected by the state or approved or patented to the state by the United States shall be examined by the persons duly appointed as provided by section three of this act and appraised as hereinafter provided by section three of this act and appraised as hereinafter provided and shall be offered for sale at such times and places as is deemed for the best interest of the state.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
