JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 10.

WHEBEAS, the achievements of our soldiers have ever been the pride and glory of our state; and

WHEREAS, the participation of one of her soldier sons in the daring and successful expedition resulting in the capture of the Tagal leader Aguinaldo has given him a world wide name as a man of courage and capability, and

WHEREAS, such acts of bravery should not go unrecognized or unrewarded,

THEREFORE be it resolved by the legislature of the state of Wisconsin in Senate and Assembly assembled, that we tender to Captain Harry W. Newton, of Superior, Wisconsin, now with the volunteer troops at Manila, our appreciation of his distinguished services in the expedition under the command of General Funston and our congratulations on his safe return therefrom; and further be it

RESOLVED, that a suitable medal be prepared under the direction of the governor of this state and by him presented to Captain Harry W. Newton at a suitable time and place, and further be it

RESOLVED, that the President of the United States be and he is hereby respectfully requested to make a suitable recognition of the services of Captain Newton by an appointment in the regular army of the United States; and further be it

RESOLVED, that our Senators and representatives in congress be requested to take such action as may be necessary; and further be it

RESOLVED, that a copy of these resolutions be transmitted to the President of the United States and to each of our senators and representatives in congress, and that an engrossed copy of the same be prepared and presented to Captain Newton.
