Legislative rights reserved. Section 4. The legislative reserves the right to amend or repeal this act.

Fishway. Section 5. There shall be built and maintained in the dam hereby authorized suitable fishways to permit the free passage of fish over and through the same.

Section 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 245.

AN ACT to authorize town boards of towns in counties having a population of 150,000 or more, to lay water mains and sewers and make assessments therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Water mains and sewers may be constructed. Section 1. The town board of every town in counties having a population of one hundred and fifty thousand or more are hereby authorized upon petition of two-thirds of the property owners in a block to build and construct water mains and sewers along the streets on which such blocks abut and adjoin and to asses property abutting and adjoining upon such streets for the cost thereof.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
