CHAPTER 77.

AN ACT to provide for the improvement of portions of streets, avenues and boulevards for park purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Portions of streets, etc., for park purposes. Section 1. In case the common council of any city of the second, third or fourth class shall determine to improve any street, avenue or boulevard under the provisions of sections 925-175 and 925-178 of the statutes of 1898, the board of public works, or if there be no such board of public works, the officer or offieers designated to perform its duties, may, as a part of such improvement, set aside and provide for the improvement of a portion of such street, avenue or boulevard for park purposes, and may determine in what manner the same shall be improved, and may assess the damages and benefits resulting from such entire improvement, including the cost of the improvement of the part of such street, avenue or boulevard so set aside for park purposes, to the several parcels of land affected thereby as provided in section 925-178 of said statutes, and shall include such determination in the report required to be made and filed by them.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
