

“and in default of payment thereof shall” and inserting in place thereof the word “or”, so that said section when so amended shall read as follows: Section 4. Whoever shall violate any of the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than one hundred for each and every offense, * * * or be imprisoned in the county jail not less than thirty days nor more than sixty days.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 100.

AN ACT relating to notice of sale of real estate, and amending section 2993 of the statutes of 1898.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Court to designate newspaper. SECTION 1. A new subdivision is hereby added to section 2993 of the statutes of 1898, to be numbered and to read as follows: 4. *The court, or a judge thereof, upon application of the party in whose favor a judgment stands, shall direct, by order, the newspaper in which the publication of a notice of sale of real estate thereunder is to be made.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
