CHAPTER 184.

AN ACT to amend section 209 of the statutes of 1898, relating to the sale of state lands.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Terms of sale. SECTION 1. Section 209 of the statutes of 1998, as amended by chapter 450, laws of 1903, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 209. Sales of all public lands shall be made for cash only, to be paid at the time of sale.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
