CHAPTER 212.

AN ACT to amend section 1, of chapter 233 of the laws cf 1901, relating to the number of reports to be printed.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Number of reports to be printed; distribution. SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 233 of the laws of 1901, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 1. Paragraph 4, section 1972b of the statutes of 1898 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Paragraph 4. The names and compensation of the persons employed by him, the whole amount of the expenses of his department, the amount of taxes and fees paid by each corporation and the amount and date of payment of the same to the state treasurer. There shall be printed and in readiness for distribution, two thousand copies of the fire and marine report, two thousand five hundred copies of the life, casualty and surety report and *two thousand five hundred* copies of the local mutual report for the use of the governor, legislature and department of insurance.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
