## CHAPTER 23.

AN ACT to suspend the sale of lands owned by the State of Wisconsin until July 1, 1905, pending the consideration by the legislature of a State Forest Reserve.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**Sale of state lands suspended.** SECTION 1. The sale of all state land outside of incorporated cities or villages, north of township 33, is hereby suspended and all such land is withdrawn from market until July 1, 1905.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 24.

AN ACT to detach certain territory from the town of Hayward, in the county of Sawyer and the state of Wisconsin, to change the boundaries of said town and to create the towns of Sand Lake, Radisson, Reserve and Winter, and to provide for holding town meetings therein.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**Towns of Sand Lake, Radisson, Reserve, and Winter created.**

SECTION 1. (a) All that certain territory in the county of Sawyer and state of Wisconsin described as follows, to-wit,—the north half (N  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of township number thirty-eight (38) north, except sections one (1), twelve (12) and thirteen (13), all of township number thirty-nine (39) north, except sections
