Conflicting laws repealed. Section 2. All acts and parts of acts in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 269.

AN ACT to authorize the county board in counties within this state having a population of 150,000 or more inhabitants to adopt and purchase voting machines for use in election precincts in any such county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

County board may adopt and purchase voting machines; payment. Section 1. The county board of any county in this state containing a population of 150,000 or more inhabitants is hereby authorized to adopt and purchase for use in any election precinct or precinets in any such county voting machines of the character and description authorized by law to be adopted, purchased and used by the common council of cities, and the town board of towns, or the village board of villages in the state of Wisconsin. Payment for any such voting machine so purchased may be provided for by the county board in such manner as it shall deem for the best interests of the county; and for that purpose such county board may issue notes, certificates of indebtedness or other obligations which shall be a charge on such county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
