## **CHAPTER** 275.

AN ACT to amend chapter 143, private and local laws of 1855, entitled "An act to incorporate the Prairie du Chien Bridge company," as amended by chapter 134 of the laws of 189*i*.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Tolls. SECTION 1. Section 9 of chapter 143, private and local laws of 1855 as amended by chapter 134 of the laws of 1897, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 9.\* The said company shall have power to demand and collect tolls for crossing the same, as follows: For any vehicle drawn by two horses, mules or oxen, twenty-five cents; for any vehicle drawn by one horse or mule, twenty-five cents for the round trip; for horses or cattle for droves of ten or less, five cents per head, and for droves of more than ten, three cents per head; for droves of swine or sheep of not more than ten, three cents per head, and for droves of more than ten, two cents per head, and for each foot passenger, five cents each way.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
