CHAPTER 315.

AN ACT to provide for the replacement of reference and professional works destroyed by the capitol fire in the library of the office of the state superintendent of public instruction and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Purpose of appropriation. Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state treasury the sum of five hundred dollars to enable the state superintendent of public instruction to replace in part, the volumes of reference and professional works destroyed by the capitol fire.
