CHAPTER 322.

AN ACT to authorize the sale of timber on public lands when it has been damaged by fire or wind.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Sale of timber authorized. Section 1. The commissioners of the public lands are hereby authorized to sell any timber on the public lands of this state which has been damaged by fire or wind, on such terms and in such manner as they shall deem best for the interests of the state.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 323.

AN ACT to appropriate a certain sum to the Washington and Ozaukee county and North Milwaukee firemen's association.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Purpose of appropriation. Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Washington and Ozaukee county and North Milwaukee firemen's association the sum of one hundred and tifty (150.00) dollars out of any money not otherwise appropriated. This appropriation is for the years 1905 and 1906 and the said sum so appropriated, shall be paid to said association in two equal payments to be made on or before the first day of June in each of said years.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
