eral state offices of the capitol, may be removed to the state land office to be placed on deposit there permanently as soon as the vaults pertaining to such office shall be made fireproof and suitable therefor.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 355.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to Thaddeus M. Talcott for boiler compound furnished to the state upon order of the superintendent of public property.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Purpose of appropriation. Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars to be paid to Thaddeus M. Talcott for six hundred pounds of boiler compound furnished by him to the state upon the order of the superintendent of public property.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
