CHAPTER 370.

AN ACT to amend chapter 93 of the laws of 1899, entitled, "An act to appropriate a certain sum of money therein named for the erection of a suitable monument for ex-governor Nelson Dewey, in this state."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Erection of monument. Section 1. Amend section 1, chapter 93 of the laws of 1899 by striking out the words "at the grave of" and inserting in lieu thereof, the words "in memory of" in the fourth line of said section.

Commission created. Section 2. Section 2 of chapter 93 of the laws of 1899 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 2. There is also hereby created a commission to supervise the expenditure of the money hereby appropriated, said commission to consist of the governor and the senator and assemblymen from Grant county. This commission shall receive no salary but all necessary expenditures to carry out the purpose of the commission shall be taken out of the sum appropriated and all moneys remaining unexpended after the completion and erection of the monument shall be covered back into the treasury.

Section 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
