## **CHAPTER 428.**

AN ACT to provide for the puchase of additional sets of Wisconsin Reports and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**Purchase of reports.** SECTION 1. The superintendent of public property is hereby directed to purchase five complete sets of the Wisconsin Reports to be used as follows: One set to be furnished to the judge of the eighteenth judicial circuit for his use and the use of his successors in office, and four sets to be deposited in the state law library, subject to being removed therefrom on the order of said superintendent, for the use of the legislature or any of the departments of the state.

**Appropriation.** SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund a sum sufficient to carry out the purposes of this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
