## CHAPTER 503.

AN ACT to amend section 1967a of the statutes of 1898 relating to appointments by the commissioner of insurance.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**Deputy and other assistants.** SECTION 1. Section 1967 of the Wisconsin statutes of 1898, is hereby amended to read as follows: Section 1967a. The commissioner of insurance may appoint a deputy who shall be known as deputy commissioner of insurance, and who shall take the constitutional oath of office and file it in the office of the secretary of state, and give such bond to the commissioner as he may prescribe; said commissioner shall be responsible for the acts and neglect of *the* deputy, who shall have the same power over all matters connected with the office of the commissioner of insurance as the commissioner has whenever detailed by him to do special acts or in case of the sickness or absence of the commissioner from the capitol. Said commissioner may also appoint a chief clerk, an \* \* \* examiner, *license clerk*, filing clerk, *two stenographers*, messenger and mailing clerk and *one general clerk*. All such appointments shall be in writing and be filed in the office of the secretary of state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first Monday in January, 1907.
