CHAPTER 510.

AN ACT to amend section 1966—49 statutes of 1898, relating to the license fee of casualty and suretyship insurance companies and to repeal chapters 130 and 413, laws of 1903.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

License fee. Section 1. Section 1966—49, statutes of 1898, is amended to read as follows: Section 1966—49. Every corporation transacting in this state the business of casualty or suretyship insurance, shall, on or before the first day of March in each year, pay to the commissioner of insurance as a license fee for transacting such business, two per cent on all premium receipts received during the preceding year, as shown by its reports made pursuant to law, on all policies or contracts which have been written in or on the lives of residents or property of this state.

Conflicting laws repealed. Section 2. Chapters 130 and 413, laws of 1903, and all acts and parts of acts conflicting herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
