## CHAPTER 517.

AN ACT to provide an additional employee in the state banking department and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Additional examiner authorized. SECTION 1. The commissioner of banking is hereby authorized to employ an additional examiner for the examination and supervision of trust companies and building and loan associations in this state. Such examiner shall give a bond in the sum of ten thousand dollars with two or more sureties or a surety company, to be approved by the governor, conditioned for the faithful performance of his official duties; he shall be paid a salary of not more than eighteen hundred dollars per annum, to be fixed by the commissioner of banking, and in addition thereto, shall be allowed all actual and necessary expenses and disbursements while absent from his place of residence in the discharge of the duties of his said office. The salary and expenses shall be certified monthly to the secretary of state by the commissioner of banking upon proper vouchers and if found correct, the secretary of state shall draw his warrant therefor upon the state treasurer and the same shall be paid out of the general fund.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
