CHAPTER 69.

AN ACT to provide for the construction of a dam across Elk creek, in the county of Dunn.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Erection of dam authorized. Section 1. Thomas B. Wilson, his associates, heirs and assigns are hereby authorized and empowered to erect, construct and maintain a dam across Elk Creek in the north-east quarter of the north-east quarter of section twenty-four (24) in township, twenty-seven (27) north, of range eleven (11) west.

Damages from flowage to whom paid. Section 2. The right to flow, flood and overflow the lands of others from such dam is limited to the right given, and subject to the damages provided for, in chapter 146 of the revised statutes of this state for the year 1898, and all acts amendatory, or that may be passed amendatory, thereof.

Rights reserved to state. Section 3. The right to repeal or amend this act is reserved to the state.

Fishways. Section 4. There shall be maintained in said dam such fishways as shall be required by the commissioners of fisheries.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
