CHAPTER 74.

AN ACT amendatory of section 2014—16 of the statutes of 1898, relating to the annual report on building and loan associations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Examiner's report. Section 1. Section 2014—16 of the statutes of 1898 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 2014—16. Said examiner shall annually, at the earliest practicable date after the reports are received, make a report to the governor of the general conduct and condition of all building and loan associations doing business in this state, including the information contained in such reports, arranged in tabular form, together with such suggestions as he may deem expedient. He shall also report the names and compensation of employes and other expenses in relation to such association, the whole amount of the income and the sources whence derived. Not to exceed one thousand copies of said report shall be printed; each local association shall be entitled to three copies, the remainder to be for general distribution.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
