by the governor and audited by the secretary of state who shall issue his warrant therefor upon the state treasurer.

## CHAPTER 16.

Noble, one hundred and fifty dollars, to \* \* \* L. N. Clausen, one hundred and fifty dollars, to \* \* \* Elmore T. Elver, one hundred and fifty dollars.
