

2. A fire proof storage building for the use of the capitol shall be erected in connection with such plant.

3. Marble or granite, or both, shall be used in the exterior construction of the capitol and of its accessories.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 20.

AN ACT to appropriate a certain sum of money for the purchase of stationery for the use of the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Office and department stationery, 1907-09; \$12,000

SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twelve thousand dollars, for the purchase of stationery for the state officers, and departments, for the years 1907 and 1908 and for the legislative session of 1909, said sum being the amount estimated to be necessary for the purposes specified.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
