CHAPTER 559.

AN ACT to amend section 2 of chapter 107 of the private and local laws of 1867, entitled "An act to authorize the appointment of a phonographic reporter for the circuit court of the counties of Milwaukee and Kenosha."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Compensation of reporters and assistants; methods of SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 107 of the private and local laws of 1867, as amended by chapter 47 of the general laws of 1871, chapter 226 of the laws of 1877 and chapter 1 of the laws of 1883 is amended to read: The sum of three thousand dollars * * per annum shall be paid to each of the four reporters appointed for the said circuit court of Milwaukee county for the service of * * themselves and assistants, which shall be in lieu of all per diem for attending said court, and for performing such other services as the court from time to time may direct, and as may be required by law. The sum of twenty-four hundred dollars of said annual salary shall be paid out of the state treasury upon the certificate and in the manner provided by section 2438 of the statutes, as amended, and the sum of six hundred dollars of said annual salary by the county treasurer of Milwaukee county * * * monthly upon like certificate, as provided by section 2438 of the statutes as amended, being filed with the county clerk of said county.
