CHAPTER 101.

CHAPTER 102.

AN ACT to repeal section 4560a—40 of the statutes, relating to licenses for fishing with nets and seines in the waters of Lake Michigan, Green Bay and Lake Superior.

SECTION 1. Section 4560a—40 of the statutes is repealed.

CHAPTER 103.

AN ACT to amend section 925—40m of the statutes, relating to the filling of vacancies in the offices of mayor and aldermen in cities of the second, third and fourth classes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 925—40m of the statutes is amended to read: Section 925—40m. In cities of the second, third and fourth classes where a vacancy shall occur in the office of mayor or alderman by reason of * * * death, resignation, * * * permanent removal from the city or ward, or other cause, the council shall forthwith proceed to fill such vacancy by the election of a qualified elector of the said city to hold such office until * * * a successor shall be elected and qualified. * *
