CHAPTER 614.

AN ACT to renumber and amend section 4959d of the statutes, relating to works of necessity or charity.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 4959d of the statutes is renumbered and amended to read: Section * * * 4959d. The keeping open of a store or shop for the sale of dry goods, wearing apparel, hats, caps, boots, shoes, hardware, furniture, crockery, glassware, jewelry, * * * coffees, teas or spices, * * * on the first day of the week, shall not be deemed a work of necessity or charity.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 615.

AN ACT to amend section 1, of chapter 309, laws of 1895, as amended by chapter 436, laws of 1901, relating to the redistricting, readjusting and changing of the boundaries of wards in cities of the first class having special charters.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 309, laws of 1895, is amended to read: Section 1. The common council of all cities of the first class, organized under special charter, may by a * * * *three-fifths* vote of all its members within two years after each state or United States census is taken and the result thereof as to its population is made known, redistrict, readjust and change the boundaries of wards so that they shall be as nearly equal in population as may be, and to that end such council may create new wards and consolidate old ones, but no ward shall be created having a population less than * * * *ten* thousand nor exceeding * * * *twenty-five* thousand.
