**CHAPTER 150.**

AN ACT to amend section 3535 of the statutes, relating to the disposition of surplus moneys in cases of the foreclosure of mortgages by advertisement.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 3535 of the statutes is amended to read: Section 3535. If after sale of any real estate made as herein prescribed there shall remain in the hands of the officer or other person making the sale any surplus money, after satisfying the mortgage on which such real estate was sold and all instalments thereof, and payment of the costs and expenses of such foreclosure and sale, the surplus shall be paid over by such officer or other person \* \* \* *to the clerk of the circuit court of the county wherein the sale was made and take his receipt therefor. Money so deposited may be applied for by and distributed to the proper party in the manner provided by law or by rule of court in the case of surplus moneys realized in foreclosure by action.* If any part of the moneys secured by the mortgage is not due and such surplus be more than enough to pay it the same shall be so paid, with interest, to the time of such payment.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect when passed and published.

**CHAPTER 151.**

AN ACT to amend section 117 of the statutes, relating to the duties of the revisor of statutes.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 117 of the statutes is amended to read: Section 117. It shall be the duty of \* \* \* *the revisor* \* \* \* *to formulate and prepare a definite plan for the order, classification, arrangement, printing and binding of the statutes and session laws, and between and during sessions of the legislature to prepare and at the beginning of each session of the legislature to present to the judiciary committee of the senate* \* \* \*, *in such bill or bills as may be thought best, such consolidation, revision and other matter relating to the statutes or any portion thereof as can be completed from time to time.*

SECTION 2. This act takes effect when passed and published.
