CHAPTER 70.

AN ACT to create subdivision (18) of section 670 of the statutes, relating to the powers of county boards.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to section 670 of the statutes a new subdivision to read: (Section 670) (18) To appropriate to any school district in which a county farm or any part thereof is situated, an amount of money for school purposes equal to the amount that would be paid as school taxes upon such farm land or part thereof situated within such district if such land were privately owned. The valuation of such farm land shall be determined by the county board of equalization.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 71.

AN ACT to amend subsection 1 of section 4565e—1 of the statutes, relating to the use of ferrets in hunting rabbits.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection 1 of section 4565e—1 of the statutes is amended to read: (Section 4565e—1) 1. It shall be unlawful and is hereby prohibited to hunt, take, kill or pursue rabbits with ferrets, or to have a ferret or ferrets in possession while hunting; *provided that in Door county it shall be lawful for any person to hunt, take, kill or pursue rabbits with ferrets on any land owned or occupied by such person.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
