## CHAPTER 145.

AN ACT to amend section $959-410$ of the statutes, relating to powers of councils as to police and fire commissions in cities of the fourth class.
The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:
Section 1. Section 959-410 of the statutes is amended to read: Section 959-410. In any city having a population of four thousand or less, sections $959-411$ and $959-41 \mathrm{~m}$ of the statutes shall only apply if the common council, by a majority vote of all members elected and the approval of the mayor, or by a twothirds vote of all of the members elected without such approval, shall adopt said sections; but the common council may at any time thereafter rescind such action by a like vote, and thereupon said sections shall not apply.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

AN ACT to amend section 905 m of the statutes, relating to street improvements in villages.

Section 905 m . The provisions of section 905 shall apply to alleys. The provisions of sections $1210 \mathrm{~d}, 1210 e, 1210 e e, 1210 f$, $1210 g$ and 1210h, inclusive, of the statutes, shall apply to villages.
