2. The clerk of all such cities, however incorporated, shall be elected by the common council of such city for a period of four years, beginning April, 1920.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 232.

AN ACT providing for the transfer of certain printed bills from the office of the Secretary of State to the State Library.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized and directed to transfer to the Wisconsin State Library, for public use and safe keeping, the set of bound printed Bills of the Wisconsin Legislature, now in his possession.

CHAPTER 233.

AN ACT to amend subsection (10a) of section 40.09 of the statutes, relating to limitation of taxes.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (10a) of section 40.09 of the statutes is amended to read: (40.09) (10a) The total amount of school district tax hereafter levied in any school district in this state in any one year for building, hiring or purchasing any school building, and for the maintenance of schools, including teachers' wages and incidental expenses, shall not exceed two and one-fourth per cent of the total assessed valuation of taxable property in such school district for the preceding year.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
