SECTION 2. Subsections (4) and (5) of section 6.45 of the statutes are repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 358.

AN ACT to amend section 3 of chapter 152, laws of 1869, entitled "An act to incorporate the Saint John's Home of Milwaukee."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 152, laws of 1869, is amended to read: (Ch. 152, laws of 1869.) Section 3. The incorporators named in the first section of this act shall constitute the first board of directors of said corporation, and shall hold their offices until the 30th day of March, A. D., 1869, when a new board of twelve directors shall be elected, three of them to hold their offices for one year, three of them for two years, three of them for three years and three of them for four years, and annually thereafter on Tuesday in Easter week, three directors shall be elected for four years, and all vacancies which may have occurred in the board of directors shall be filled by the votes of the members of said corporation, including life members, each member having one vote. No person shall be eligible to be elected a director who is not a male member of said corporation, and a member of or regular attendant at some one of the Protestant Episcopal churches of the county of Milwaukee, and a layman, and said board of directors shall be chosen as equally as practicable from the several Protestant Episcopal congregations in Milwaukee county. *The Bishop of the Protestant Episcopal church in the diocese of Milwaukee shall be ex officio a member of the board of directors of said corporation.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
