**CHAPTER 528.**

AN ACT to appropriate to O. H. Eliason, state veterinarian, a sum of money named therein, to reimburse him for moneys spent for attorney's fees in defending an action.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to O. H. Eliason of Madison, Wisconsin, state veterinarian, the sum of two thousand dollars for attorney's fees incurred and paid by him in defending a suit brought against him, growing out of his refusal as state veterinarian to countersign certain interstate certificates issued by Dr. A. H. Hartwig of Watertown, Wisconsin; provided, however, that this appropriation shall be in full settlement of any and all claims of said O. H. Eliason against the state, growing out of said matter.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

**CHAPTER 529.**

AN ACT to create section 50.08 of the statutes, relating to county out-patient departments or public health dispensaries.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. A new section is added to the statutes to read: 50.08 PUBLIC HEALTH DISPENSARY. Any county may establish and maintain an out-patient department or a public health dispensary for tuberculosis and other communicable diseases; which may also be used in connection with the correction of physical defects of school children and child welfare work. In counties whose population is two hundred and fifty thousand or more such institution shall be governed either pursuant to section 46.21, or sections 46.18 and 46.19. In all other counties it shall be governed pursuant to sections 46.18 and 46.19.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
