## CHAPTER 154.

AN ACT to amend subsection (4) of section 20.11 and section 35.305, and to create subsection (6) of section 20.11 of the statutes, relating to the printing of the proceedings of the veterans' organizations, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (4) of section 20.11 and section 35.305 of the statutes are amended to read: (20.11) (4) Annually, beginning July 1, \* \* 1925, a sum not exceeding \* \* \* three hundred dollars to carry out the provisions of section 35.305.

35.305 Upon receiving the necessary printer's copy, the state printing board shall have at its discretion printed and bound in suitable form, by the state printer, and delivered to the proper officer of each organization, all required copies of department orders, rosters and historical matter and also of the annual proceedings of any Wisconsin organization of soldiers, sailors, marines and army nurses of the civil war, the Spanish-American war, or of any of our subsequent wars, and of the auxiliaries of the United Spanish War Veterans of Wisconsin and of any of our subsequent wars.

SECTION 2. A new subsection is added to section 20.11 of the statutes to read: (20.11) (6) The sum of thirty-nine dollars and nine cents to pay bills incurred during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1925, for printing the proceedings of the Wisconsin department of Spanish War Veteran's Association.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
