CHAPTER 339.

AN ACT to create subsection (5) of section 29.62 and subsection (11b) of section 20.20 of the statutes, relating to the removal of injurious rough fish by the conservation commission and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. A new subsection is added to section 29.62 and a new subsection is added to section 20.20 of the statutes to read: (29.62) (5) The state conservation commission shall also cause rough fish to be taken at any time of the year from any lakes located in counties which are entirely north of forty-four degrees thirty minutes north latitude.

(20.20) (11b) The state conservation commission shall expend from the appropriation for operation of the state conservation commission, authorized by subsection (1) of section 20.20 of the statutes, on July 1, 1925, fifteen thousand dollars to carry out the provisions of subsection (5) of section 29.62.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
