CHAPTER 177.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money to H. E. Manzer for services and stenographic expenses in connection with the investigation of the state highway commission by a special joint committee appointed pursuant to Joint Resolution No. 15, S. and for transcripts furnished the executive office.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to H. E. Manzer the sum of eight hundred fourteen dollars and twenty-three cents, being six hundred fifty-six dollars and fifty-two cents for services rendered, transcripts made and carbon copies furnished in connection with the investigation of the state highway commission by a special joint committee appointed pursuant to Joint Resolution No. 15, S., and one hundred fifty-seven dollars and seventy-one cents for a copy of the stenographic report on such investigation furnished the executive office.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 178.

AN ACT to repeal sections 52.01, 52.015, 52.02 and 52.03, and to create three new sections to be numbered sections 52.01, 52.02 and 52.03 of the statutes, relating to colonies for the feeble-minded.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 52.01, 52.015, 52.02 and 52.03 of the statutes are repealed.

SECTION 2. Three new sections are added to the statutes to be numbered and to read: 52.01 (1) The purposes and objects of the "Northern Wisconsin Colony and Training School," located near Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, and the "Southern Wisconsin Colony and Training School," located near Union
