antinable disease exists shall be placarded by the health officer while the disease is present and until disinfection. The expense of maintaining quarantine, including examinations and tests for disease carriers and the enforcement of isolation on the premises, shall be paid by the city, incorporated village or town upon the order of the local board of health.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 202.

AN ACT to amend subsection (2) of section 59.35 of the statutes, relating to duties of the deputy coroner in certain counties.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (2) of section 59.35 of the statutes is amended to read: (59.35) (2) The coroner of any such county may appoint a deputy who shall assist the coroner in the performance of his duties as he may direct, and who, under the direction of the coroner, may exercise all of the powers and perform all of the duties of the coroner, and in case of his absence or disability or of a vacancy in his office shall perform all the duties of such coroner during such absence or until such vacancy is filled, and may appoint such other assistants to the coroner as the said county board may authorize.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
