## CHAPTER 301.

AN ACT to create section 49.18 of the statutes, relating to poor relief.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 49.18 of the statutes is created to read: 49.18 Unless the board or council shall have designated some other official therefor, the town chairman, village president, mayor, or chairman of the county board, when in his opinion reason therefor exists, shall provide temporary medical relief for a poor person, and liability for expenses so incurred shall be the same as though incurred by the board or council.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
