(2) Any person guilty of common barratry as defined in subsection (1) shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail not more than six months or by fine not exceeding five hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 401.

AN ACT to amend subsections (1) and (5) of section 20.14 of the statutes, relating to appropriations for the free library commission.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsections (1) and (5) of section 20.14 of the statutes are amended to read: (20.14) (1) Annually, beginning July 1, * * 1927, * * forty thousand * * * dollars for the execution of the functions of said commission, other than the work of the legislative reference library and other than the purposes of subsection (2) of this section. Further, all moneys received by each and every person for or on account of said commission shall be paid, within one week after receipt thereof, into the general fund, and are appropriated and added to this appropriation. The members of the commission shall receive no compensation, but shall be paid their aetual and necessary traveling expenses incurred in the discharge of their official duties.

(5) Annually, beginning July 1, * * * 1927, * * * twelve thousand five hundred dollars, for the operation of the library school as provided in subsection (4) of section 43.09.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1927. Approved July 18, 1927.
