CHAPTER 453.

AN ACT to repeal subsection (1) of section 64.01 and section 64.14 and to create subsection (1) of section 64.01 and section 64.14, relating to the adoption and abandonment of the city manager plan of city government.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (1) of section 64.01 and section 64.14 of the statutes are repealed.

SECTION 2. A new subsection is added to section 64.01 and a new section is added to the statutes to read: 64.01 (1) Any city of the second, third, or fourth class may reorganize under the provisions of this chapter either by enactment of a charter ordinance or by a petition and referendum election as provided by section 66.001 of the statutes. Such petition and election shall be governed by subsections (2) and (5) of section 10.43.

64.14 Any city which shall have adopted the provisions of this chapter may abandon the same and reorganize under the provisions of chapters 62 or 63, or under a home rule charter by proceeding in accordance with the provisions of section 64.01.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
