## CHAPTER 17.

AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section 59.05 of the statutes, relating to the signing of county orders.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 59.05 of the statutes is amended to read: (59.05) (1) The county board, at the first meeting after each regular election at which members thereof are elected for full terms, shall elect one of their number chairman. A person so elected shall perform all duties required of the chairman until the county board elects his successor. The chairman may administer oaths to persons required to be sworn concerning any matter submitted to the board or a committee thereof or concerning any matter connected with their powers or duties. He shall countersign \* \* all ordinances of the county board, and shall preside at all meetings when present. Unless otherwise directed by ordinance of the county board he shall countersign all county orders.
